Congratulations to Ryan Larkin who was the 3rd year overall winner of the mangahigh.

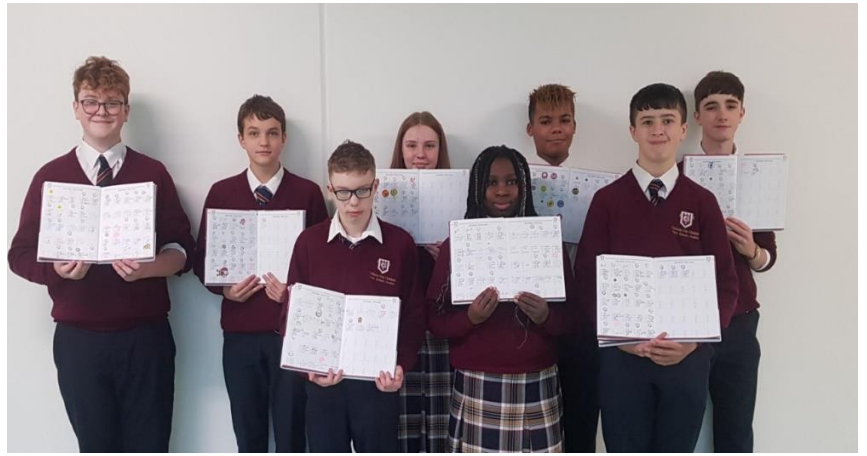
